

3. History and Significance Samuel Shaw was of the second generation of the Shaw family in Bath. He was born in 1838 and was one of eight children of Sylvester and Harriet Shaw. In September 1860 he married Lucy Webster. In 1874 he owned 70 acres divided in 2 lots. By 1891 he owned 70 acres in one lot.
